To use a **New Moon** manifestation day, within 48 hours **after** the **New Moon** has occurred, simply write down a maximum of ten wishes of what you would like to experience and watch life offer you opportunities to magically bring them about. Written words act as magnets that pull you towards accomplishing your goals. Sample Wishes: "I want to easily find myself creating a routine that gives me plenty of time for work, play and study. I wish to manifest the job, the body, the hair, the nose, etc. that I desire into my life (with a disclaimer *'in a happy way'* or *'if it be in the highest good'*)." Plant seeds on the **New Moon**. Watch them come to fruition on the **FULL Moon**. Astrology encourages us to do positive things for ourselves on the day of an **Eclipse** because that creative energy remains with us for 6 months. A **BLUE Moon** is when a **FULL Moon** occurs twice in the same month but if it's a **Taurus FULL Moon**, etc., only the energy of the 1<sup>st</sup> **FULL Moon** counts as the **WESAK Festival**. Believe, Desire and Expect.

**Aries** is **new beginnings** that require a measure of courage. It rules initiative, taking action, self-assertion and Spiritual Warrior. **EASTER Festival** celebrates the Risen One and is spiritual high point of the Christian year, fixed by the Aries **FULL Moon**. **Taurus** rules money, comfort, material possessions, appreciation, sensual enjoyment, attachment, perseverance and patience. **WESAK Festival** celebrates Buddha's Blessing of compassion to humanity. It is the **most powerful time** of year to meditate. **Gemini** rules information, writing, speaking, learning, teaching, communication, transportation and curiosity. **CHRIST'S Festival** celebrates the Spirit of Humanity aspiring to God. Observed since 1952 as **World Invocation Day**. **Cancer** rules home, real estate, immediate family, security/insecurity, feelings of belonging, nurturing, caring and patriotism. **Leo** rules children, fun, play, vacations, pleasure, risk-taking, determination, self-confidence, creative will, passion and romance. **Virgo** rules health, diet, exercise, routines, handling details, organization, work/job, service, pets and practical solutions. **Libra** weighs two things like a seesaw. It rules balance, harmony, indecision, relationships and committed partnerships. **Scorpio** rules self-mastery, discipline, taking risks, transformation, empowerment, forgiveness, integrity and courage. **Sagittarius** rules freedom, adventure, Truth, solutions, intuition, consciousness, optimism, belief in a Higher Power and trust. **Capricorn** rules taking charge of matters and FULL responsibility for creating the successes you want and setting priorities. **Aquarius** rules friendship, equality with/desire to help others, "one world" awareness for the greater good and humanitarianism. **Pisces** rules addictions, escape tendencies (drugs, alcohol, food, sleeping), spiritual ideals, compassion and unconditional love.
